

Glenwood General and Playground Rules

- Toys of any kind are not allowed at school – this includes iPods.
- Cell phones are kept in backpacks or on the teacher’s desk and must be turned off until 3:15pm.
- Students may not ride scooters or bikes on school grounds. They must dismount and walk before entering campus or the footbridge on Knight Drive. Third, Fourth, and Fifth grade students may ride or scoot to school by themselves. Kindergarten - 2nd grade students must be accompanied by an adult.
- Bike and scooter riding is allowed on school grounds after 4:00 P.M. only.
- Students may arrive on school grounds only after 8:30 A.M. and must go directly home after dismissal unless accompanied by their parent or guardian.
- Students should sit down to eat snack before playing and during lunch.
- Students should use designated trash receptacles and follow the directions of the Green Team helpers during lunch clean up.
- Students should remain in supervised areas.
Off limit areas include:
 - Snack bar, dugout, and bleacher areas
 - In between portables or on the ramps of portables (during recess)
 - In breezeways between classroom wings (during recess)
 - Far side of field, near fences (students should use the “three big steps rule”)
 - Bushes at edge of field and behind PTA shed
 - Lunch tables during play time.
 - Areas of main Little League field that are covered with tarps.
 - Any classroom when the teacher is not present.
- Students may leave yard only after checking with teacher or staff on duty.
- Students must check with yard duty before retrieving balls from off limits areas.
- Students should only kick soccer balls and utility balls. When the grass is dry, all “big” ball games should happen there.
- Balls can **only** be used against:
 - Back of concrete dugout
 - Both sides of ball wall
- Students may not bring balls to school.
- Students may retrieve balls from the ball basket only *after* they have eaten their snack.
- Running and tag games should be played on the grass area. Running is not allowed on the blue mat under the play structure or in the tanbark of the K yard structure.
- Bathrooms and play structures are to be used for appropriate uses only.
- Slides are for going down only and one student at a time.
- Rope Climbing Structure: Climbing is allowed on the ropes only, not on the metal frame.
- At the end of each recess the students will “pause in place” when they hear three short whistles. They remain in place until they the second round of three short whistles.
- Gaga Pit:
 - No more than 25 students allowed at one time in the pit.
 - Students must take their “outs” when the ball hits them below the waist.
 - If there is a dispute, students will use “rock paper scissors” to decide if the student in question is out.
 - The game is played until there are two students left and then the students on the outside of the pit begin counting from 25 to 1. When they get to 1, the pit is filled again.
