### **Welcome @ 6:05pm**

(Tami McCall) Nicole Cibellis is attending her second meeting, and she has made a Thrive donation, so she will be a voting member going into the new school year.

(Kyri McClellan) Katie Klesius is helping with the new Superintendent process so she is not here tonight.

(Dena Richardson) Thank you to everyone who is doing the corporate matching! We had several last minute ones come in. \$210K total Thrive donations this year! Cisco matches their employees time with monetary donations.

(Ashley Walter) We were at the Kindie Orientation and it went really well. Son's Night went really great too!

(Cielo Kirk) Spring Sing went well. We had a lot of great feedback from the teachers and parents. Looks like we might keep it outside again next year. Everyone seems to like it outside. Went smoother this year than in past years. Jason took a lead role as the MC and keeping everyone in check during the event. Field Day is set for tomorrow. We purchased a few things we needed for this year. The Art Show is great, but I'd like to discuss doing it at a different time of year than Spring Sing. She only has ½ the students for the first part of the year and the other ½ the second half of the year.

(Heather Moore) Maybe we should have an Art Gala, twice a year.

(Kyri McClellan) Dad's Club End of Year BBQ is happening as far as I know. Since we cancelled our Read-A-Thon, we raised a lot more money for HeadsUp's Rockin' Run.

(Jaclyn Guelfi) Auction date is March 21st and we put a deposit down at Terrapin.

(Kyri McClellan) Budget Review.

(Kathryn Elia) Thrive went over, and Auction came in a little under, so we're pretty balanced. I am keeping Thrive at \$200K for next year. We cut a lot of stuff this year.

The question is do we want to keep what we have going now? The Dad's Club did not make their budget this year, so we'll have to supplement about \$1K. Education Consultant fees will be a wash next year. No changes to the Teacher's budgets. Classroom Enrichment is staying at \$5K per grade level. \*Discussion about having more yoga next year\*. Art and Science use a lot of materials. PE expenses went down since we use the National Academy of Athletics PE program now. We're in the black, which is great, about \$40K.

(Mr. Treewater) In the past, the GSF used to give the Glenwood teachers a year end bonus of like \$100-\$200 as a Thank You. It went a long way.

(Mr. Treewater) Teachers are wrapping it up. Kindergarten is getting ready for their moving on ceremony. 1st: living organisms. 2nd: Oakland Zoo field trip; biomes. SBAC is almost done. 3rd: geography play. 4th: Sac trip was great. 5th: studying family life; Glenwood University. Teachers are finishing assessments for the last report cards.

(Jason Richardson) Tomorrow is our ribbon cutting at 8:45am. I shared with the Site Council that the audio that was installed is less than great. District installed a couple of things and now it is much better. Projector is going to be installed soon. Field Day is also tomorrow. At the Site Council level, I'd like to see some clarity around the roles of the GSF and the Site Council. I'd like to see the GSF funding what the Site Council proposes. We'll have to have some discussions around that. Separately, I got some pushback about the way I spoke to the kids about the no-alcohol policy for Spring Sing.

(Tami McCall) Parents specifically said they had an issue with the term "sober".

(Jason Richardson) When I was hired as the Glenwood Principal the number 1 thing I was told by the District was I needed to work on curbing the Glenwood parent's bringing alcohol on campus.

(Kyri McClellan) Next up is the GSF Board slate for next year. Kathryn is stepping down as our Treasurer and Mr. Treewater is not returning as our Teacher Rep. Mrs. Bordley will be our new Teacher Rep. Nicole Cibellis is coming on as our VP of Fundraising. Alison Rabb will be pairing up for Schools Programs. Kirstin Maguire is stepping up as Comms. A few others are moving around. We can have up to 16 GSF Board Members per the bylaws.
